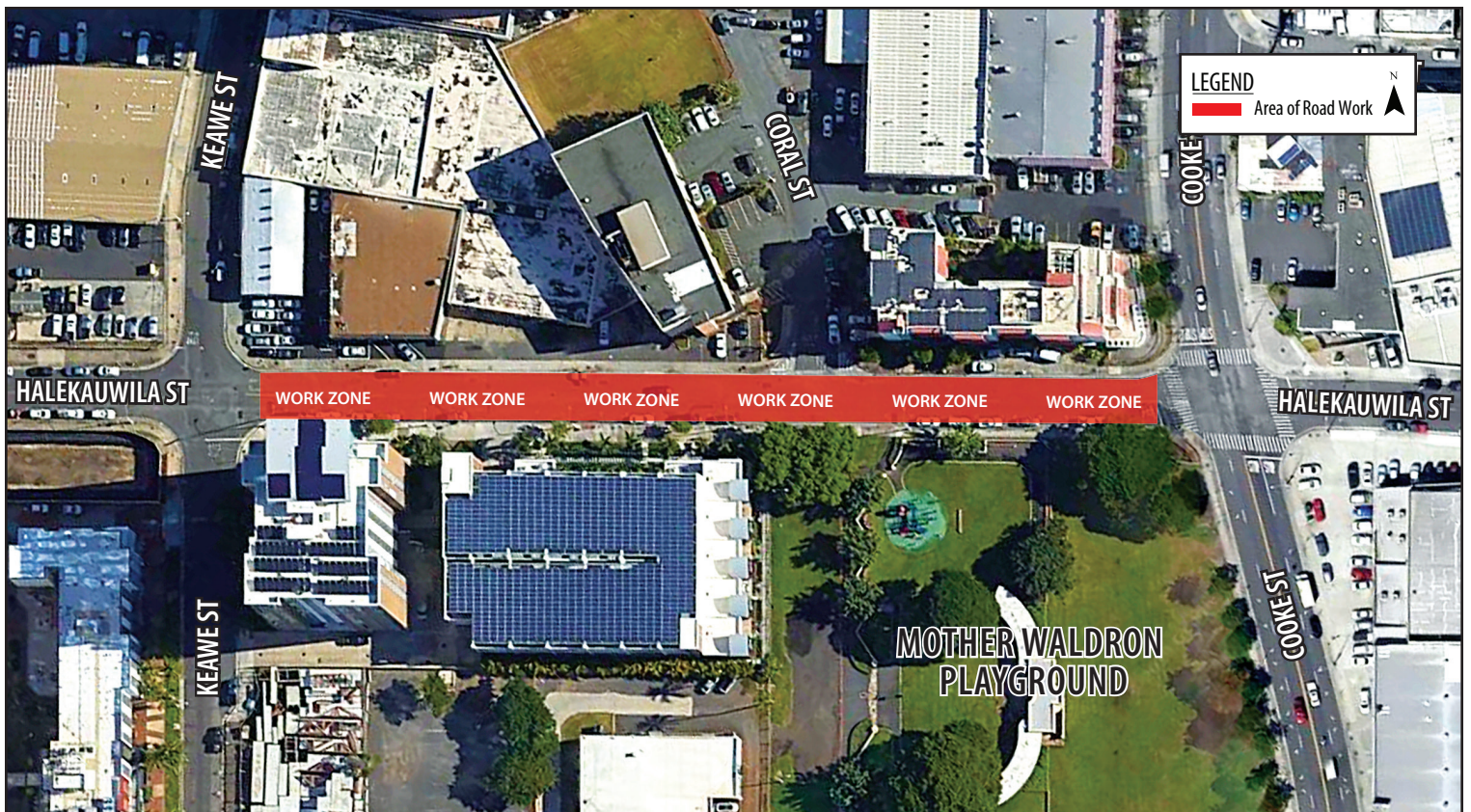


HALEKAUWILA STREET LANE CLOSURE NOTICE

FROM KEAWE STREET TO COOKE STREET

Estimated Start: Mid-October 2019

The Honolulu Authority for Rapid Transportation (HART) would like to notify area residents and businesses of construction work to upgrade the Honolulu Rail Transit Project’s utility infrastructure in the area. The area may experience an increase of noise and traffic delays. For the safety of work crews and the traveling public, please observe construction signage.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

WORK SCHEDULE

Day Work

Work Duration: 3 Months

Monday to Friday

8:30 AM to 3 PM

- Intermittent lane and road closures. On-street parking will be restricted. Personnel and special-duty police officers will be onsite to assist pedestrians and commuters as needed.
- Business and residential access for vehicles will be maintained. Pedestrian access will also be maintained.
- For safety, the speed limit will be reduced to 15 mph in both directions.

TRAFFIC SAFETY



It is everyone's kuleana (responsibility) to be mindful of changing roadway conditions in construction zones. **A few minutes of patience and alertness on the road can save a life.** Below are a few helpful tips for your morning and afternoon commutes.

PLAN AHEAD

Lane reductions and turn restrictions may impact your commute. Allow extra time through the construction zone, especially during school drop-off and pick-up times.

EYES FORWARD

Road conditions may change around a work area. Minimize distractions and stay alert for construction workers, vehicles or pedestrians.

SLOW MEANS SAFE

Follow posted speed limits while traveling within construction zones. Construction zone speed limits have been lowered to 25 miles per hour.
